



Riverworks, an installation comprising three large painted panels by Sydney based artist Susan Baird, marks the completion of a recent commission awarded by the Mirvac Group in consultation with the City of Canada Bay Council.

Inspired by the historical use of significant tracts of land along the Parramatta River foreshore, the work reflects the optimism of a bygone industrial era. Award of the commission was the culmination of an extensive selection process with more than sixty artists from around Australia and overseas submitting proposals .

The work has recently been installed in the main lobby of a new commercial complex located in Rider Boulevard in Rhodes.

“Winning this commission has been a great experience for me as an artist. I really enjoyed the research aspect and having the opportunity to create a work of this scale to share with the broader community. It was really exciting to see the painting being installed at Rider Boulevard and to meet the expectations of the designers from Mirvac and the Canada Bay Council. I feel very proud of this painting and love the space it is hanging in.”
